BREAKFAST CLUB

The new Breakfast Club food ordering system has been running for over a week now and children seem to be enjoying the food choices available. To avoid disappointment, only food which is ordered via The Pantry (using the 'Order Snack & More' button) before 7am will be available for children on the day; however, your child does not need to eat when they come to Breakfast Club.

CHANGES IN THE NEW YEAR

From Monday 8th January 2024, Breakfast Club will be starting at 7.45am each day, which we hope will help our working parents. Please note that we can only accept children between 7.45am-8.20am.

Due to staffing costs, we are raising the daily charge for Breakfast Club attendance to £1/day for families who are entitled to benefit-related free school meals and £2/day for all other families. This daily charge will need to be paid via Parent Pay. Please see the school office if you want help with this.

Thank you to all the families who ensure their children's accounts are always in credit. However, from 8th January, staff will only be able to accept children into Breakfast Club who have sufficient funds in their Parent Pay account.

YEAR ONE IS TAKING PART IN THE FIVE TO TWELVE STUDY

Pupils from our school have been selected to take part in the new **Five to Twelve** study! Five to Twelve is a new national study involving around 8,000 children attending primary school in the 2020s and their families. The study will explore how children are getting on in a range of areas in the post-pandemic context. By following children and their families over time, the study aims to provide a contemporary understanding of how children's environments and experiences impact on their future education and wellbeing outcomes.

For the first stage of the study, the National Centre for Social Research (NatCen), which is delivering the study on behalf of DfE, will be sending letters to the parents or carers of the selected children at their home address in October 2023. The information posted to families will list the various ways they can get in touch with the study team, should they have questions about participating or opting out.
