



Top tips for managing your child's asthma in Winter









Breathing in cold, dry air can irritate the small airways of the lungs. If your child's asthma is well controlled they are less likely to be triggered by cold winter air.





It is important for your child to use their preventer inhaler every day as prescribed, even if they appear well and always use their space

Make sure you give the school a copy of their asthma plan, a named spare reliever inhaler and spacer for your child to use

Give your child a scarf to wear scarf loosely over their nose and mouth. It warms up the air they're breathing in, so they're less likely to get asthma symptoms.

Make sure you book an appointment with your GP for your child's asthma review

And don't forget to carry their reliever inhaler with you all the time, so you can act quickly if cold weather triggers their asthma.
