Assessing Smartphone Readiness

Is my child old enough to have a phone?" It's a common, understandable question from many parents, but it's also one that is very difficult to answer as there are so many factors involved. For younger children it's often peer pressure and with older children, social isolation is very common. Often, advice has to be given particular to that child/family, rather than a one-size-fits-all solution.

The Institute for Digital Media and Child Development have put together some tip sheets for parents which we think are really useful. There are 3 parts:

- Assessing readiness.
- Preparing for healthy use
