

#### Who are Home-Start?

Home-Start Hillingdon is a small charity helping local families, with at least one child under 5, who are finding things tough with issues including post-natal depression, isolation and managing difficult personal circumstances.

We recruit, train and manage volunteers to come alongside families with young children who are struggling. Each volunteer supports one family, visiting 2-3 hours once a week for up to 6 months to give support, befriending and practical help towards achieving the goals the family set themselves.
