A reminder to all parents that the school does not authorise holiday during school time. We ask that parents call the school office before 8.45am if your child will be absent for any reason. Whole school attendance from the start of term is 94.4% and for the week beginning 25/09/2023 is 94.6%.


LINK TO HOPE - SHOEBOX APPEAL

ADULT COOKERY COURSES

Learn Hillingdon, have planned some Cookery Workshops in their Uxbridge Adult Education Centre, Civic Centre, Uxbridge, UB8 1UW for families in receipt of certain benefits e.g. Universal Credit, Housing benefit and more.

The first programme are workshops JUST for parents: 'Let's Create Tonight's Dinner' and will be on Wednesdays, 11th and 18th October and 1st and 8th November 12.30-2.30pm.

All ingredients will be supplied, and you will be able to take home a dinner for that evening.

The second Programme is for parents AND children (a maximum of 2 children (age 5+) per adult to do together. Again, these will be on Wednesdays, same dates as the first programme but at 3.30-5.30pm.

During the sessions you will learn how to make a variety of healthy snacks with your child/children.

Sessions must be booked, and you can attend a maximum of 3 sessions (you can ask to be put on the waiting list and contacted if there are spaces).
