Each week, we would like you to choose one of the main activities to complete – these can be done in any order at all.

1. In Science, we will be learning about habitats. Draw and describe a habitat (e.g. desert, Arctic, micro-habitat, jungle). Can you think which animals might live there and why?
2. Roll 3 dice and add up the score. Get an adult to do the same. Who scored more? Can you beat your adult? Record your scores and who won the game!
3. Practise counting in steps of 2, 5 and 10. Can you write out your times tables or count up/down in 2s, 5s and 10s? (e.g. 3, 5, 7, 9... or 86, 76, 66, 56 etc).
4. Come up with some expanded noun phrases to describe farm animals (e.g. the large pink pig, the fat spotty cow). Can you put these into some interesting sentences?
5. Spend 20 minutes on a Literacy or Numeracy activity on DB Primary. Write or draw what you have learnt.
6. We are reading 'The Sheep Pig' in Literacy. Can you write a recount of one part of the book?
7. Set yourself some Maths problems to develop your addition, subtraction, multiplication or division skills.
8. Draw a picture of a farm animal and label its body parts. Can you explain what jobs the farm animals are used for?
