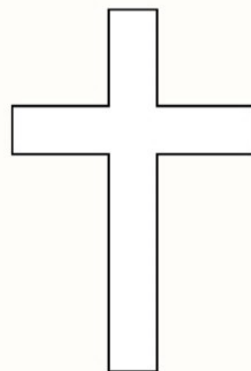

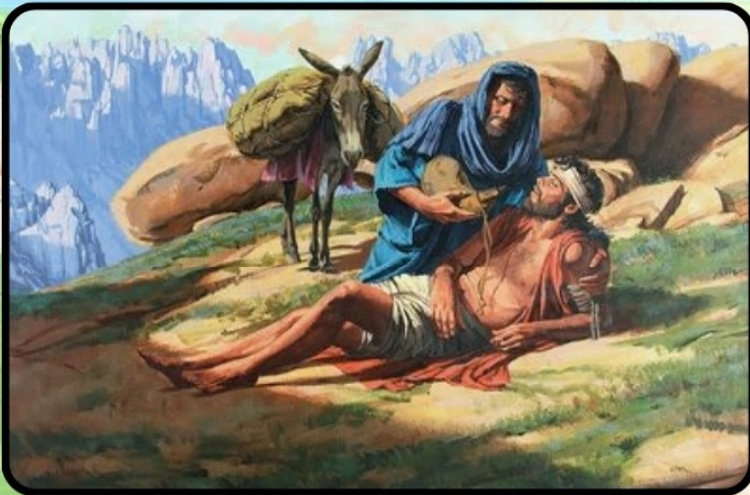


We have been thinking about
The Good Samaritan

A man was travelling along a lonely road when robbers attacked him, took everything he had, and left him badly hurt. Two people walked past but did not stop to help. Then a Samaritan came along.

Although Samaritans and Jewish people were not usually friends, he stopped, cared for the injured man, and made sure he was safe.
